INTERACTIVE TOURS FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

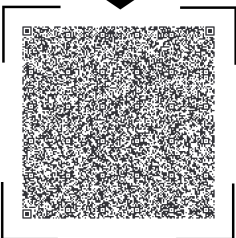
